



Korokipo Branch Agricultural and Horticultural Tertiary Bursary

Bursary Regulations

Focus:

To encourage residents of Hawke's Bay to undertake further education or training in land-based courses, either through university or polytechnic institutes. Bursary recipients will ideally seek employment in the Hawke's Bay area to ensure that the benefits of their learning can be passed on to the Hawke's Bay community and its industries.

Level of Study:

Enrolment at a University, Polytechnic or College.

Purpose:

Available to tertiary students to assist with enrolment in tertiary education.

Value and Tenure:

at the discretion of the Korokipo branch, up to \$2000. One year only duration.

Eligibility:

Applicants must:

- be an NZ citizen
- available for tertiary students who are studying fulltime and who have completed their first year of study
- applicants must live within the district boundaries of Wairoa, Napier, Hastings or Central Hawkes Bay
- the course of study should be in the agricultural or horticultural fields, e.g. agriculture, aqua-farming, beekeeping, horticulture, silviculture, veterinary or viticulture
- applicants will be required to attend an interview.

Selection Committee:

This Bursary is awarded by the Rural Women New Zealand Bursary Committee consisting of appointed members by the National Board of Rural Women New Zealand.



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Application Checklist:

- character reference from a member of Rural Women New Zealand, outlining the need for assistance
- character reference from another responsible citizen (non-family member), from someone who is known to the applicant
- proof of enrolment in the proposed course of study
- an outline of how the applicant's study will be of benefit to the wider community as well as to their personal development.
- a copy of the previous year's study results or the last school report (if within three years), or an academic reference

Selection Considerations:

Applications will be acknowledged by the National Office upon receipt.

Applications will be treated as confidential and are subject to the provisions of the Privacy Act.

Applicants who are granted a Tertiary Bursary and withdraw from full-time study before the end of the academic year, may be obliged to refund the whole or part of the Bursary as determined by the Rural Women New Zealand National Board.
