

**Bursary Regulations** 

#### Focus: Boarding.

### Level of Study:

Year 9 or Year 10.

#### Purpose:

The Secondary School Boarding Bursary is available for students who must live away from home in order to attend secondary school.

### Value and Tenure:

\$900 per year. Can be awarded for up to four years per recipient.

### Eligibility:

Applicants must:

- be a New Zealand citizen
- in Year 9 or 10
- living away from home.

### Selection Criteria:

The bursary is not primarily awarded on a basis of performance, academic achievement or outstanding scholarship, but is to aid students who must live away from home in order to attend secondary school.

### Selection Committee:

This Bursary is awarded by the Rural Women New Zealand Bursary Committee consisting of appointed members by the National Board of Rural Women New Zealand.

### Application Checklist:

- a letter outlining the reasons for needing financial assistance, written by a parent or caregiver
- a supporting letter from the principal or a current teacher
- previous results/last school report/academic reference
- character reference from a member of Rural Women New Zealand, outlining the need for assistance
- character reference from another responsible citizen (non-family member) who is known to the applicant.

### Selection Considerations:

Applications will be acknowledged by the National Office upon receipt.

Applications will be treated as confidential and are subject to the provisions of the Privacy Act.

Applicants will be notified of the Bursary Committee's decision which will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into. Annual bursary payments will be made to successful applicants in April, upon receipt of confirmation of secondary school enrolment for the year.

Payment will be made directly to the principal caregiver, who must advise Rural Women New Zealand immediately if the applicant leaves school or is no longer boarding away from home. Where a successful applicant does not complete their school year a proportional refund of the bursary payment may be required.

Reports on the applicant's progress throughout the school year would be gratefully received by Rural Women New Zealand.
